We are located in North Huntingdon Township off Robbins-Station Road just outside of Irwin.

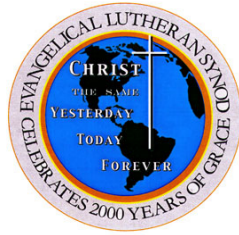
From Pittsburgh

These worship services follow the Orders of Worship found in The Lutheran Hymnal (©1941) which is the book of worship used in the congregation.

Sunday School is held at 9:30 AM each Sunday. Sunday school classes from Kindergarten through Adult classes are taught.



The Sacrament of the Alter

The first Sunday of each month (and some other special Worship Services) Zion celebrates Holy Communion.

It is the true Body and Blood of Jesus Christ in, with, and under the Bread and the Wine; instituted by our Lord Jesus Christ given for Christians to eat and to drink for the assurance of the forgiveness of our sins.

Altar Fellowship is also a statement of the unity of belief in all the doctrines of the Confessions of the Evangelical Lutheran Church.

Those desiring to commune with us that are not members of Zion, or members who have not communed in the past 3 months will please talk with Pastor at least 15 minutes before the Service begins concerning our Biblical "close" communion practice.
